

Rules & regulations of Fairmount Cemetery

1. The cemetery board will have full control of the future planting of the cemetery. It will be at the discretion of the board as to what trees are planted, trimmed or removed.
2. The cost of a cemetery lot, five burial spaces is \$250. Each single grave space is \$50.
3. The cost of a full burial is \$300. A cremation burial is \$150. Any weekend burials will be an extra \$100 charge. Cremains must be placed in a durable container and there can be two burials per space.
4. There will be a \$500 to exhume a body from the cemetery.
5. Permanent decorations cannot be placed at the cemetery without board approval.
6. The American Legion is responsible for the flags and flagpoles that are part of the avenue of flags.
7. Any stone must be set on a base of a minimum of 18" thick, with a minimum of 6" wide margin. Anything other than a standard marble non-traditional headstone must have board approval before placing. Headstones must fit in 36".
8. All monuments will be erected and serviced from the road and all excess dirt and concrete must be removed from the cemetery.
9. No more than on lot (5 burial spaces) per family may be purchased without board approval.
10. It is the policy of the cemetery board to settle graves with water. If families prefer that water not be used, there will be an additional charge of \$75.00.
11. No burials are permitted by anyone other than the sexton or a funeral home.
